PROTOCOL	Inclement weather
ISSUES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Need to have a consistent approach towards implementing inclement weather timetables and supervision of students
AIMS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To clarify the application process for inclement weather timetables• To ensure adequate supervision of students• To ensure that staff receive adequate break time
EXPECTED BEHAVIOURS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Avondale Primary School defines inclement weather as days with temperatures at or over 35° C at Essendon Airport, or wet days.• Once an inclement weather program is announced then students will remain inside for the duration of the break.• Wet day program announcements that occur when students are already in the yard should ask student to line up in their <u>Wet Day line up area.</u>• Students must remain in their own classrooms and be supervised at all times.• Class teachers will share supervision with the teacher next door, or a specialist teacher – see timetable.• If teachers were already scheduled to do a yard duty during that recess or lunch time, they would do their supervision at that time.
